<b>El Picador - Merlot, Chile 2021 13.5%</b> Medium bodied, with a lovely sweet plum fruit and a mellow, soothing finish. Vivid ruby red. Cherry, plum and a hint of spice on the nose. Medium-bodied, elegant and smooth palate with a good body and length.	£21	£5.30	£7.60
<b>Morador Tinto - Tempranillo, Navarra, Spain 2020 14%</b> A brilliant red- garnet colour with clean and intense aromas of ripe cherry fruit develop in to a fresh palate of berry fruit with a delicate hint of vanilla.	£22	£5.70	£8.20
<b>One Chain The Wrong 'Un- Shiraz/ Cabernet, Australia 2020 14%</b> A rich, well balanced example of the Aussie classic blend. Lush black fruits coupled with touches of woodspice, liquorice and cassis follow through to a delicious, velvety finish.	£24	£6.00	£8.60
<b>Los Haroldos Chackabuco - Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina 2021 14%</b> A mix of plum, raspberry and blackberry, medium-bodied, yet soft and silky with seductive tannins. The purity of this wine is a natural acidity which complements the fruits in a great, lengthy finish.	£27	£6.50	£9.40
<b>Viña Cerrada - Rioja Crianza, Spain 2017 14%</b> Striking plum above other various red berries, classic vanilla with a touch pepper, kicking at the end. Medium body making justice to its ageing and good finish.	£27		
<b>Le Fou - Pinot Noir, France 2021 13%</b> Bright ruby red, with upfront aromas of freshly-picked raspberries and an underlying savoury leesiness. Fleshy red fruits continue to the palate and are joined by fine tannins and juicy acidity - the foundations of a serious Pinot Noir.	£27		
<b>Domaine Mas Barrau - Cabernet Franc (Organic), France 2021 13.5%</b> Textured and luxurious this is a sophisticated Cabernet Franc from Gard. There is a wild 'after the rain' woodland perfume. The palate is incredibly long and layered with bramble fruit, bay and a touch of sweet prune on the finish.	£28		
<b>Ginestet Classique - Lussac-Saint Emilion, Bordeaux, France 2019 14%</b> A very classy Claret nose leads on to a ripe, flavoursome Merlot palate, smooth with a pleasingly long finish.	£35

<b>Monterey Bay - Zinfandel Rosé, California, USA 2019 10.5%</b> Quite the most delicious wine, a racy mix of watermelon and cherry with a delectable sweetness.	£24	£6.00	£8.60

<b>El Picador - Sauvignon Blanc, Chile 2021 12.5%</b> A fresh Sauvignon Blanc with ripe gooseberry notes and a crisp, lingering finish. Bright greenish yellow. Vibrant grapefruit aroma, with lemon and other citrus fruits. Light balanced and fresh with mouth-watering flavour.	£21	£5.30	£7.60
<b>Decanal - Pinot Grigio, Venetie, Italy 2021 12%</b> With an unmistakable and immediate nose of acacia flowers, the palate is dry with ripe lime fruit, well balanced and very personal.	£22	£5.70	£8.20
<b>Water Stop - Chardonnay, Australia 13%</b> This vibrant Chardonnay exhibits lifted fruit character, bright tangerine fleshiness, textural mouthfeel, a bright palate and a long and foodie finish. Contains Milk.	£24	£6.00	£8.60
<b>Ugalde - White Rioja, Spain 2020 13%</b> Delicate citrus and stone fruit aromas, white flower and a hint of orange blossom. The palate has texture, minerality and balance with stone fruit and citrus characters, crisp acidity and an elegant, lengthy finish.	£25	£6.30	£9.00
<b>Zagare - Vermentino, Sicily, Italy 2021 13%</b> Ripe stone fruit aromas with preserved lemon characters and floral notes. The palate has bright citrus peel and grapefruit, an appealing texture and minerality, fresh acidity and a gently savoury finish.	£26		
<b>Domaine de la Combe - Muscadet, France 12%</b> Crisp, flinty notes with a hint of yeasty lees on the nose. The palate has a lean acidity with a slight spritz, with some bready and almost savoury citrus aromas.	£28		
<b>Tabalí Pedregoso - Gran Reserva Viognier, Chile 2018 13.5%</b> This Viognier presents rich aromas of citrus, orange peel and dried apricot, fresh pears and white peaches, plus hints of candied fruit. Delivers on the palate as well as the nose, with floral, honeyed and citrus flavours combining with chalky minerality. Bright and expressive, this has a soft rounded texture and great purity.	£28		
<b>Ornezon - Picpoul de Pinet, France 2021 13%</b> Ornezon is cultivated supporting sustainable agricultural practices by the eco-friendly Florensac producers. Their vineyards are on the higher levels about ten kilometres from the famous landmark Mediterranean sea-lake Bassin de Thau. Here, the cooling sea breezes invigorate the charming natural fruitiness of this Picpoul de Pinet with freshness and structure. Made to be relished on it's own or at table, fantastic chilled with shellfish and seafood.	£29

<b>Ill Caggio - Prosecco, Italy 11%</b> Small and lively bubbles burst onto the tongue. A smooth mousse and subtle wild apples and pear fruits exude from the palate with a refreshing lift on the finish. Fit for a celebration, though ideal for a toast on any occasion.	£26	£8.30
<b>Domaine Jean Perrier et Fils - Cremant de Savoie, France 12.5%</b> Well balanced with good depth and classic Champagne-esque toasted brioche flavours and creamy notes evident again, giving this complex wine an appealing softness.	£46	

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
